- The installation, service and maintenance of this light fixture must be performed by a licensed electrician. If you are not qualified, contact a licensed electrician.
- Product installation must comply with the National Electrical Code and all local electrical and building codes and regulations.
- DO NOT install if product is damaged.
- Prior to installation, maintenance, inspection or removal, turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box.
- Do NOT use input power other than the voltage specified on the Product Specifications.
- Do NOT install in wet environments where directly exposed to water.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.
- Ensure that your installation matches all elements shown in the photographs and drawings of the installation instructions before you begin.
- Do NOT make or alter any openings in the housing of the light fixture during installation.
- Do NOT allow the wiring to contact sharp edges, such as sheet metal edges.
- This recessed light fixture is intended for mounting only in a covered ceiling (where LED side of light fixture will only be exposed to damp or dry locations, not wet locations)
- Do NOT use this light fixture in or with exit signs or emergency light fixtures.
- Wear gloves and safety glasses at all times when removing light fixture from carton, installing, servicing, or performing maintenance.
- Avoid looking directly into light while on.

CAUTION: RISK OF FIRE

• Keep combustible and other materials that can burn away from light fixture and lamp/lens.

Retrofit Installation

ATTENTION: Ensure that the power to recessed housing is switched off prior to beginning installation.

- 1. Remove existing lamp(s).
- 2. Remove existing reflector and retaining clips from mounting frame and discard.
- 3. Open the side board of junction box.
- 4. Locate the junction box containing supply wires and cut all supply wires leading to ballast. Remove the wires connected to the ballast if necessary.
- Twist out the conduit knockout.
- 6. Install and connect the supply to the input wire and ground wire.
- 7. Install the downlight kit in the mounting frame by lifting upward on both mounting springs. Push the kit until it sits flush against the ceiling.
- 8. Once installation is complete, restore power.


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New Construction Installation

ATTENTION: Ensure that the power is turned off at the source to the location in which you are installing the product.

- 1. Cut a ceiling hole according to the dimensions provided.
- 2. Open the cover of the junction box and insert lamp conduit into the junction box.
- 3. Connect the black wire to the live wire, white wire to neutral wire using connectors and cap off the ground using wire nut. Close the cover of the box.
- 4. Squeeze the two housing clips into an upright position and insert lamp into the ceiling.
- 5. Release the housing clips and push lamp into ceiling until secure and flush.
- 6. Once installation is complete, restore power.
